Learning new approaches to interacting with our participants and teaching horsemanship will be one of the positive outcomes of these times.

Therapeutic horsemanship is a largely experiential learning format. It draws on a hands-on approach that is rich with consequential growth. During a pandemic that has proven to not be the most ideal situation. We have had to get out of our traditional box and find new ways to reach our riders.

Our focus has been teaching riding and pre-riding skills, but in addition to that we also work on social skills, critical thinking, confidence and a whole array of emotional and physical goals. We have developed a series of zoom classes to offer these learning opportunities as well as social gatherings for our crew.

We do so much more than riding. Zoom will help us reach out to participants who may not be able to come out in person and it will allow them to still learn about horses and each other. In the future we will continue to offer remote learning for that very reason. In years to come our remote learning can be used as an introduction to our program and continuing education for our riders.
