

Eagle Mount Great Falls PONTOON BOAT LUNCH CRUISES 2019

Trips are not guaranteed-Weather and water levels are always considered before trips. We will cruise as safety allows. Please read the guidelines below. If you have any questions or want to schedule trips, call 454-1449.

GUIDELINES:

1 Hour Lunch Cruise

Please contact the office for available trip days/times. Trips are scheduled between July 15 and August 23. Trips are not guaranteed as stated above.

- Please bring your lunch! This is a lunch cruise. We will be going very slow so you can enjoy your lunch on the river while site seeing.
- Your arrival and departure location will be at Broadwater (across from Applebee's). Please arrive at least 5-10 minutes early to allow time to load the boat. Also, have your ride ready at Broadwater 5-10 minutes early before pick up to ensure your ride is there on time since we may not be able to dock and wait with you. **Please do not wait or come onto the boat dock until AFTER the boat captain has cleared you to load – this is for your safety! Boats docking come in contact with the boat dock and may cause rocking or sudden jolts that could create falls. All passengers need to be escorted on and off ramp for the same reason.**
- Boat trips are \$10 per person/trip. All attendees must have a signed liability form completed before being allowed to cruise. We will have water and an assortment of small snacks on board.
- The boat will only wait 10 minutes past the time of the scheduled trip. If you will be more than 10 minutes late, the boat will leave and your trip will be rescheduled if a date is available. All trips, no matter what time we leave the dock, will end at the scheduled time.
- Be sure to use the bathroom before loading the boat. There is a bathroom at Broadwater Bay.
- To ensure everyone has an enjoyable time, Eagle Mount strongly recommends to NOT bring people that have a fear of the water or are unable to sit still on their own. We need to ensure everyone's safety and enjoyment.
- Cancellations: We will make every effort to reschedule trips canceled but it is not guaranteed.
- Capacity: ***7 people (max) are allowed on the Pontoon Boat per group (including your staff).** We would like to have at least 5 clients (not including your staff) to make the trip worthwhile – so 5 clients and 1 or 2 staff would be ideal. Depending on weight/size of people and number of wheelchairs will ultimately determine the number of people allowed per trip.
- Boaters need to dress for a chilly breeze that may come off the water. Sun protection (hats, sunscreen, sunglasses) is always recommended even though there is some shade on the boat.
- Wheelchairs: We encourage transferring your client into a seat if possible. There is space on the boat for up to 2 manual wheelchairs. Having 2 wheelchairs on the boat limits the amount of seating. **NO ELECTRIC WHEELCHAIRS - NO EXCEPTIONS.** Our ramp to the boat will not fit oversized wheelchairs. Clients will have to walk on if they come in an oversized chair.
- Passengers in wheelchairs or with walkers – please be aware that the boat dock has a small slope from the ramp to the main dock that can be hard to maneuver unless someone is assisting. Heavier chairs and passengers with severe mobility challenges will need extra assistance. (see picture)
- No Smoking
- No Alcohol
- Anyone under the age of 12 MUST wear a life jacket. There are life jackets available for any and all boaters, provided by Eagle Mount.
- All participants must remain seated at all times. Safety is Eagle Mount's upmost concern while on the river. Your captain is the Eagle Mount representative that is driving the boat. Please follow all instructions and rules expressed by your captain. Eagle Mount has the right to refuse service to anyone for any reason.
