Volunteer Eligibility Criteria

Alpine Ski and Snowboard Program

General Program Volunteer Eligibility Criteria

- Minimum age: 16
 - Volunteers must provide their own skiing or snowboarding equipment and must wear protective equipment required for the activity (helmet).
 - Complete a volunteer application and liability waiver.
 - Must have own transportation to Showdown Resort.
 - Volunteers must possess intermediate or above skiing or snowboarding skills.
 - Volunteers must attend orientation class at Eagle Mount Great Falls and practical skills training at Showdown Resort prior to working with participants.
 - Volunteers must complete a background check.
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Program Volunteer Incentives

- Volunteers receive a free lunch on the days that they are working with participants.
 - Volunteers receive a free day pass for the days that they are working with participants.
 - Volunteers that work 4 events receive a free day pass that can be used at any time.
 - Volunteers that commit to working 8 or more days in a season will receive a free season pass for the following year.
